

Understanding Internet Connection Speeds

That's why it's important to understand how internet connection speeds work to ensure you select the right speed for your household's needs.

Download vs. Upload Speeds

When you're choosing an internet plan, there are two speeds you need to consider: download speed and upload. The download speed is how quickly data travels from a remote location on the internet to your device. For example, if you're watching a video on YouTube, the download speed is the rate at which the information in the video stream travels from the YouTube server to your computer or phone. The upload speed is how quickly data travels from your device to a remote location on the internet. For example, if you post a video or photo on Facebook, the upload speed is the rate at which the information travels from your device to the Facebook server.



Why Download Speeds are Often Faster

With most internet plans, the download speed is greater than the upload speed. This is because many online activities—like web surfing, video streaming, and application downloads—involve downloading a lot of data so the faster you can do that, the better. The upload speed may also be important for you, depending on the type of activities you do online. An amateur photographer who regularly uploads high-resolution images to a photo-sharing site may want to consider ordering an internet plan with a faster upload speed. Likewise, if you work from home, you may also require a faster upload speed.
